I feel honored in inviting you to join the Summit. Your presence and inputs will greatly enrich the deliberations. I look forward to an early positive response.

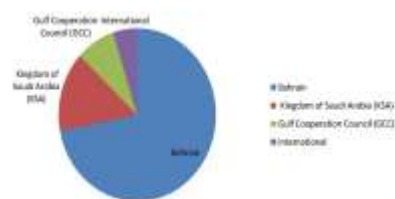

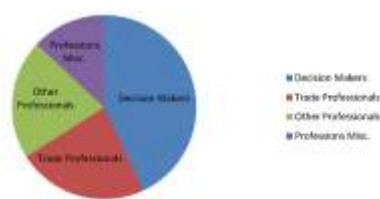

### Visitor Statistics:

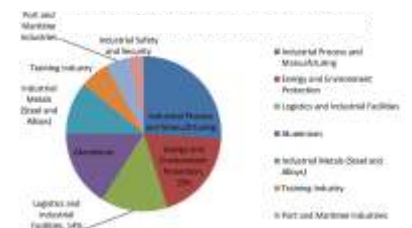
**Visitor Profile by Country (2016)**
